PORT OF PALM BEACH WELCOMES HEAVY POWER

RIVIERA BEACH, Fla. – A two-year venture began this week when the Port of Palm Beach received its first shipment of 100-ton power modules from Korea.

The 21 modules, varying in length up to 42 feet, were off-loaded from the big lift vessel *MV Tracer* at the port by Teeters Agency & Stevedoring. Beyel Brothers Crane & Rigging is handling the specialized logistics and transport of the modules to western Palm Beach County where they will be part of a transmission station.

The Port has already confirmed six vessels importing the heavy lift cargo until April 2008 and looks forward to the continuous shipments over two years.
