Duke of Top Sail, first cargo ship to sail from POPB to Marsh Harbour following Hurricane Dorian

Riviera Beach, Florida – October 2, 2019 – On Wednesday, a Bahamian owned cargo ship named the Duke of Top Sail, was loaded with much needed supplies that will be shipped to Marsh Harbour. Port of Palm Beach tenant, Heavy Lift Services Inc., transported the supplies from its warehouse to Berth 17, where the Duke of Top Sail docked.

The lower hold of the vessel was filled with plywood, roofing materials and fertilizer. All of which will be unloaded in Marsh Harbour. There are also two golf carts being shipped.

This is the first ship to travel from the Port of Palm Beach to Marsh Harbour following Hurricane Dorian.
