appurtenances, spares, and  
equipment appertaining whether  
onboard or not, in rem,

The property shall be sold separately,  
"As Is, Where Is" basis at public  
auction. The successful bidder shall  
be required to pay a deposit of earnest  
money equal to \$500.00 or 10 percent  
(10%) of the bid price, whichever is  
greater with the U.S. Marshal at the time  
and place of sale, and the remaining  
90 percent (90%) of the bid shall be  
paid within seven (7) days thereafter.  
All payments to the U.S. Clerks of  
Courts shall be made in certified  
check or cashier's check drawn upon  
a first-class commercial bank with

District of Florida. Failure to pay the  
balance in accordance with the terms  
of the sale will result in the forfeiture  
of the monies deposited and the  
property will be reoffered for sale.  
The sale is subject to confirmation  
by the court and the parties have  
reserved the right to oppose such  
confirmation if the bids received are  
deemed inadequate. If an objection  
to the sale is filed within the time  
permitted by Local Admiralty Rule  
E(17)(g), the successful bidder is  
excused from paying the remaining  
purchase price until seven (7) days  
after the court confirms the sale.
